Agreed Code of Conduct

Players, officials and spectators of Blue Mountains Water Polo Association matches are expected to uphold the best traditions and ethics of sport and sportsmanship – in all aspects of the game.

In signing this Registration Application, the player agrees to abide by the rules and by-laws of the New South Wales Water Polo Association. Accordingly, any person or persons who bring the game into disrepute will face disciplinary action from the Association. In particular, the following misconduct by any member of the Blue Mountains Water Polo Competition will not be tolerated:

- Backchat to referee = automatic exclusion and miss playing 2 matches
- Disrespect shown towards an official (refer WP22.10)
- Brutality or dangerous play of any form (refer WP22.9)
- Obscene or foul language (refer WP22.8)

Grievance Procedures

The following outlines what you/your parent should do if you have a grievance within Blue Mountains Water Polo Club.

1. The person with the complaint (the complainant) should attempt to discuss the issue directly with the person/people involved in the issue or incident.
2. The complainant should lodge a formal complaint with the club President. If needed the club may decide to conduct a tribunal hearing and/or investigation into the matter.
3. People involved with the complaint participate in a mediation meeting.

The process most appropriate to resolve a conflict will depend upon the nature of the issue, version of events presented by the complainant, respondent and witnesses and resources available to the club. For more detailed information about correct grievance procedures see Blueys website.
